## ✿Columbia Road Flower Market✿



*It's a magical world of colourful plants and exotic flowers. Wonderful atmosphere*

Over 30 garden shops and cafes.  
Old and new merge wonderfully together to create an atmosphere which visitors cannot resist. The market is now visited by 1,000's of garden enthusiasts every Sunday, You can search for rarities or general plants at wholesale prices. The stock and prices change every week.

### ✿Guided tour of the Huguenots of the Spitalfields Area✿

Spitalfields is towered over by the soon to be restored Nicolas Hawksmoor's, Christchurch. On the corner of Fournier Street and Brick Lane, stands a building, which sums up much of the area's history. Once a Huguenot Church today it is a mosque: previously it was a Methodist Church and a Great Synagogue It was built in 1742-4 when French was the dominant language of the area. You have a choice to join the walk through the streets of Spitalfields where in these very streets Jack the Ripper chose his victims or spend free time in the old market.

### ✿Old Spitalfields Market✿

One of the oldest markets in London. If you are looking for something original, of excellent quality and value for your money this is the place to be. This is a good place for second-hand books, collectibles and clothes. Food holds the floor here: organic fruits and vegetables, pickles relishes and preserves, confectionery and home-made breads and wines. The emphasis on the natural extends to crafts such as unbleached clothing

### ✿18 Folgate Street✿

The House is a time capsule sometimes opened up. Its creator Denis Severs, an artist and who lived in the house in much the same way as its original occupants might have done in the early 18<sup>th</sup> century. This he did for his own personal enjoyment, as well as for the harvest of an atmosphere which he then employed to provide the visitor with an extraordinary experience. To enter its door is to pass through a frame into a painting one with a time of its own.

Coach drops you off at Columbia Road Market for 2 hours then picks you up with your purchases. Then you travel by coach the short distance to Old Spitalfields Market. Where you have the choice of free time in the Spitalfields Market Curry in Brick Lane or a visit to 18 Folgate Street plus you can take our guided walk around the historic Spitalfields Area.
